

60Hz Curves






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Locked Rotor Motor Starting Curves





De-Rates

All values tabulated above are subject to the following reductions:

- 3% for every 5°C by which the operational ambient temperature exceeds 40°C

Note: Requirement for operating in an ambient exceeding 60°C and altitude exceeding 4000 meters must be referred to applications.
