







Three Phase Efficiency Curves

60Hz Curves










Locked Rotor Motor Starting Curves





De-Rates

All values tabulated above are subject to the following reductions:

- 3% for every 500 meters by which the operating altitude exceeds 1000 meters above mean sea level
- 3% for every 5 °C by which the operational ambient temperature exceeds 40 °C
- For any other operating conditions impacting the cooling circuit please refer to applications

Note: Requirement for operating in an ambient exceeding 60 °C and altitude exceeding 4000 meters must be referred to applications.
